ANNUAL BUDGET

One of the primary responsibilities of the Board of Education is to secure adequate funds to conduct a quality program of education. The annual school budget is the operational plan, stated in financial terms, for the conduct of all programs in the school system. It is a legal document which describes the programs to be conducted during the fiscal year, and is the basis for the establishment of tax rates.

The annual school budgeting process is an important function of school district operations, and should serve as a means to improve communications within the school organization and with the residents of the community.

Public school budgeting is regulated and controlled by statute and state regulations. A budget is required for every fund that a school system uses in its yearly operation.
