

DELETION OF COURSES/PROGRAMS

Decisions for deleting a course/program:

- A. Curriculum areas/departments may initiate deletion of a course/program while making annual assessments and recommendations to the administration in order to offer instructional programs that best meet student needs.
- B. A course/program will be considered for deletion if student enrollment is not sufficient to cause the inclusion of the course/program in the master schedule for a full year. Exceptions may be made when the deletion of the course would seriously damage the curriculum.
- C. A course/program may be considered for deletion due to budget limitations of the school district.
- D. All deleted course/programs shall be identified, with justification, in the annual curriculum recommendations forwarded to the Curriculum Coordinating Council. Following the council's approval, the recommendations will be forwarded to the superintendent and Board of Education for approval.
