PROGRAMS FOR STUDENTS WITH DISABILITIES

The Pattonville School District is part of the umbrella district (Special School District of St. Louis County) that serves students with disabilities in St. Louis County.

It is the policy of the Board of Education to provide a free and appropriate education for students with disabilities.

Students with disabilities are those who, because of certain atypical characteristics, have been identified by professionally-qualified personnel as requiring special educational planning and services. Students will be identified on the basis of physical, health, sensory, and emotional handicaps, behavioral problems, or observable exceptionalities in mental ability. It is possible that a student may have more than one type of disability.

The District's programs and services available to meet the needs of these students will be in accordance with The Individuals with Disabilities Education Act, The Americans with Disabilities Act, and The Rehabilitation Act of 1973, Section 504. In addition, the identification of students with disabilities and the services provided by the District will be in accordance with the regulations and guidelines of the Missouri Department of Elementary and Secondary Education's current Plan for the Individuals with Disabilities Act.
