STUDENT FUND-RAISING ACTIVITIES

The Board prefers that the School District support student activities by adopting an annual school budget that provides sufficient funds for an enriched educational program. It may be necessary in a few instances, however, for students to raise funds to help support some of the activities. Approval for such fund-raising efforts must be secured from the principal, or designee, and will be restricted to that which is considered necessary by him/her.

These fund-raising activities and projects must be approved by the principal before the activity is initiated. The solicitation of funds via sales of products or donations and contributions is expressly prohibited without consent of the principal.

Fund-raising activities will be conducted in accordance with the general statutes, Board policies and procedures, and directives from the principal or superintendent. These activities shall be approved and monitored by the principal of the school and conducted in such a manner so as not to conflict with law or the educational process in the school. The sale of anything during instructional time as a fund-raising project for student activities is prohibited.
