CLASS SIZE

The Board recognizes that class size is an important aspect in an effective educational program, and is directly related to the amount of teacher work. It also recognizes that establishing and maintaining a satisfactory class size can contribute to students achieving academic success.

Therefore, the goal for K-12 class size and assigned enrollments is to meet or exceed minimum Missouri School Improvement Program standards. The board may, when class size moves beyond this goal, approve of additional teachers and/or paraprofessionals if funding and space permit. A secondary course will be reviewed by the administration if class size drops below 10 students.
