

GRADUATION EXERCISES

Because the Board believes that completion of the requirements for a diploma from the public schools is an achievement that improves the community as well as the individual, the Board wishes to recognize that achievement in a publicly celebrated graduation exercise.

Accordingly, an appropriate graduation program may be planned by the senior high school. Elementary and middle schools may hold promotion exercises, but formal graduation programs for these grades are prohibited.

Students must have earned all required credits and completed the 50-hour community service requirement to participate in the graduation ceremony. The high school administration will determine on an annual basis the date by which all graduation requirements must be completed. Parents, students, and staff will be notified of the dates in the customary senior year informational letters.
