

FIRST AID

The school will provide an emergency form for parents to return on each child designating person to contact with three alternate names and current information, name of physician, desired hospital, and other specific health information.

IN CASE OF ACCIDENT OR ILLNESS:

1. The school will provide immediate and temporary first aid care to sick and injured students.
2. The school will be responsible for providing adequate facilities, first aid supplies, and will make every effort to have at least one staff person in each building who is trained in first aid and CPR.
3. Policies and procedures should have written approval from local medical providers. A consulting physician may write standing orders and protocols for illness and injury care for that particular school staff, including use of emergency drug kits.
4. Students who become injured or ill at school should be evaluated by history of signs and symptoms before being moved. Parents or guardians will be notified regarding the student's serious complaint and/or symptoms. Instructions to the parent will include need for exclusion or further treatment.
